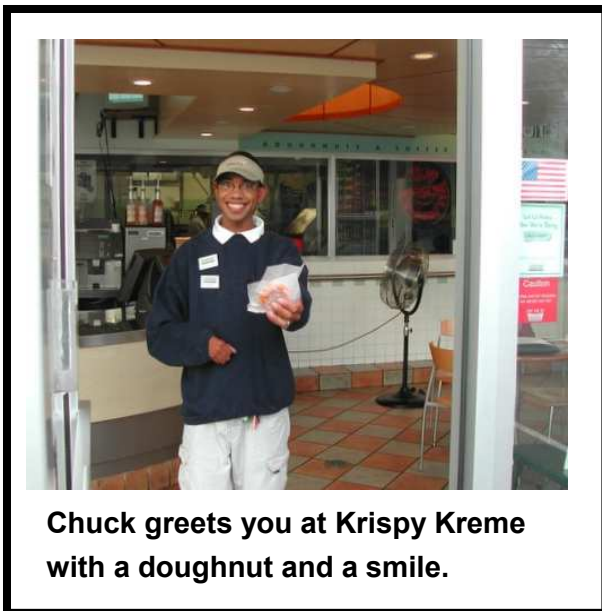


Options Unlimited is a non-profit, supported employment agency that has been connecting good employees to work since 1985.

What services does Options provide?

Our services are intended for individuals with a wide range of disabilities who require support to find, learn and keep a job. Many individuals who have never worked before or have never worked successfully are able to do well with assistance provided by our supported employment counselors. Individuals referred to us from the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation have been assisted to work successfully through supported employment and follow up services.

Depending on the individual's needs, Options may arrange interviews, set up tours and provide on site assistance.

How will my program work?

Each person referred to Options Unlimited for Supported Employment is treated as an individual. We will look at your level of participation and plan employment goals based on your interests and needs. We help develop your job-seeking skills, assist with resume writing and the interview process as needed. Together we will look for potential job sites that fit your employment needs. Options can provide on the job training as well as on going follow up to ensure your continued success.

Supported employment moves people toward independence with competitive employment. The on going support system increases employment retention and encourages people to work to their full potential.

Who funds these services?

The primary sources of funding for our employment services are the Kentucky Office of Vocational Rehabilitation, Seven Counties Services, Medicaid SCL Waivers, fundraisers and private donations.

Special Programs

Options works to ease the transition from school into the workforce for high school students involved with the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation. If you feel your student is eligible for these services contact the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation in your county.

In addition, we have specialized services for people who are Deaf and Hard of Hearing. We have two staff members who are proficient in American Sign Language and knowledgeable of Deaf Culture.

Interpreter services can be arranged and are available for individuals referred to Options for supported employment services.
